The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has reviewed the Series C Standardized Permit Application for the Storage Facility at 7300 Chevron Way, Dixon, Solano County, California (Application).

In accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 22, section 66270.10, DTSC has determined that the subject Application is technically complete. DTSC will prepare a Draft Hazardous Waste Permit and a California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Initial Study and Negative Declaration. These documents will be made available for public review and comment during the forty-five day comment period. DTSC will also hold a public meeting prior to the issuance of a final permit decision. If DTSC determines that additional information is needed to clarify, modify or supplement previously submitted material, DTSC reserves the right to require this information from D/K Dixon.
