Permit Renewal Application For California Resources Elk Hills, Kern County, California 93276

California Resources Elk Hills submitted a Permit Application for a Hazardous Waste Post Closure Facility Permit to Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) to allow the continued post closure care of the closed Hazardous Waste Trench on May 29, 2018.

The closed Hazardous Waste Trench is located one mile west of Elk Hills Road on the north side of Skyline Road.

The closed Hazardous Waste Trench received neutralized acids and tank bottom sediment between 1975 and 1985. In May 1993, DTSC certified the closure of the Hazardous Waste Trench and issued a permit for post closure.

DTSC finished the initial review and determined the Application to be administratively complete on June 15, 2018. The current permit will remain effective until a final decision on the Application is made. If the application is determined to be technically complete, DTSC will then prepare a draft permit for public review and comment. If DTSC renews the Permit, the Facility could continue Post-Closure care activities for the next ten years.
